Kids' Robotics Competition Is A Learning Opportunity

A demolition and renovation of the former Laika Entertainment Studios facility was recently used to teach a team of middle school students and aspiring robotic engineers about dealing with construction waste.

Caleb Beaudin, JHC Senior Project Manager and father of team member Nico, offered the use of the JHC jobsite located at Northwest 22nd Avenue and Pettygrove Street. The building is being repurposed as creative office space for client Kensington



Investments.

The student team is one of thousands of students across the country participating in the LEGO league competition, developing projects for the future use of robotics. The demolition debris had been separated into various piles such as wood, metals, drywall etc.

The students brainstormed for many hours and ultimately decided to focus on the re-use and re-purposing of the mountain of pink fiber glass insulation. The team decided to robotically mix the fiberglass with epoxy, which creates a solid that can be shaped using molds. They will use it to design cars and trucks.
